We are Gabriela and Carolina Hansen and this is our gift to our dad, Paul Hansen. What follows is a letter from Carolina and I to serve as our contribution to the work he does for sick kids and the dad he is with mom's help.

Letters from Well Kids in Texas to Well Kids in Boca Raton, Florida, Palm Beech County, and the state of Florida: My name is Gabriela and I'm twelve. I live in Temple, Texas and my dad flies sick kids to a height of 5,000 feet and turns the controls over to them with their parents in the back seat. We are called, The Flying Vikings. Pilots get needed air time and landings. Sick kids and their family get a day of enjoyment and I along with those that serve get fulfillment. I help by raising money to pay for the gas and repairs. Over thirty pilots show up on a Saturday morning and take kids and their family flying. Home Depot, Chili's, and Papa John's provide food and entertainment on the ground. We are all volunteers. My sister Carolina and I are part of a writing exercise to be put in a book and we would like for you to join us. I am also working on an internet show that I hope will be aired at BYL Network in Boca Raton. The show will be called, Not 1 of the 6. I am helping produce parts of a segment called, "The Be Sweet Moment." This segment was named after nine year old Mikaila Ulmer who owns Bee Sweet Lemonade. She has been on Shark Tank, named Entrepreneur of the Year for the city of Austin, Texas and has been making lemonade with honey since she was four years old. She has her lemonade sold in various stores in Texas including Whole Foods. She wants to be a doctor that owns a soft drink company not the other way around. She donates 20% of her earnings to helping take care of bees. Einstein said without bees mankind would starve to death. Us kids have enough to worry about in this country without thinking about starving. We also help fund Water for Africa in Round Rock, Texas. To raise money needed we search for people of value often students for they have the heart and the will to help those less fortunate. We find kids that do ordinary things incredibly well and work together to solve problems. Will Clark a 16 year old in Tyler, Texas has helped fund over 400 natural disaster recovery efforts since he was six. Will lived in New Orleans before Hurricane Katrina. How can you say I don't when we have never met.
